**Cray North Yorkshire**

There are several fine waterfalls in Cray Gill, each with their own unique attraction, including the spectacular Crook Gill, Cow Gill Close and Cray Gill Falls, with water cascading over limestone rock tiers into sparkling pools below. Cray is a small hamlet on a steep hill above upper Wharfedale, dating from 1202. It lies on the original Roman Road linking Bainbridge with Ilkley, which descended from Kidstones Pass to Buckden, a handsome village on the River Wharfe beneath Buckden Pike (702m).

**Spurn Head Lighthouse East Yorkshire**  
 This distinctive red and white lighthouse was built in 1895 and was in service for 90 years on Spurn Head, a striking 4.8km-long, narrow sand spit, forming the north bank of the Humber Estuary. The Humber Lifeboat Station is also based here. Spurn is a haven for wetland and migratory birds, where seals and porpoises may be sighted offshore. There is a bird observatory and a National Nature Reserve. It is a delicate environment, continually reshaping itself through silting and coastal erosion.

**Rotherham South Yorkshire**  
 Set on the banks of the Rother and the Don, Rotherham has been a market town since the 11th century. It expanded during the Industrial Revolution; firstly due to coal, and later through the prominence of the cast iron and steel industry. Rotherham Minster is a gothic church with fine stained-glass windows, dating back to the 14th century. With its tall spire, it is Rotherham's most predominant landmark. Nearby is the historic Chapel on the Bridge, which crosses the River Don, built in 1483.

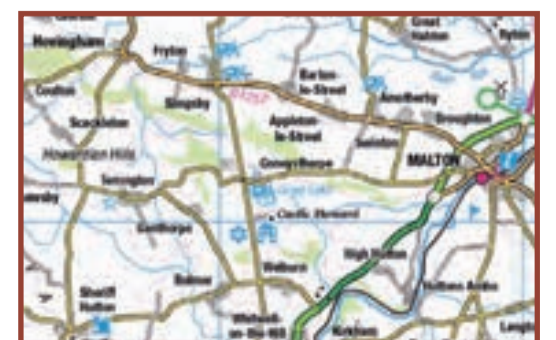

**Castle Howard North Yorkshire**  
 Castle Howard is set in 1,000 acres of stunning landscape in the Howardian Hills. The extensive grounds of this grand stately home include formal gardens, manicured parkland, obelisks, towers and follies, two lakes, splendid fountains, and a colonnaded mausoleum, resting place for the Howard family. Designed by Sir John Vanburgh in 1699 for Charles Howard, Earl of Carlisle, it took almost 40 years to build. The baroque cupola, designed by Nicholas Hawksmoor, was modelled on St Paul's Cathedral.

**Scarborough North Yorkshire**  
 The majestic Scarborough castle was built in the 12th century as a stronghold for Henry II in a naturally defensive site, commanding spectacular views out to sea, on a rocky promontory at the edge of vertical cliffs, approached by a narrow isthmus. Repeatedly besieged in the next centuries that followed and damaged by German naval bombardment in 1914, the ruins of the castle keep, curtain wall and round towers still dominate the busy historic seaside town with its glorious beaches and harbour.

**Grassington Yorkshire Dales**  
 This picturesque small market town, with stone houses, shops and a busy cobbled market square, dates back to the 12th century. Surrounded by rolling hills, farms, fields and pastures grazed by sheep and criss-crossed by dry-stone walls, in a wide glacial valley, it is home to the Yorkshire Dales National Parks Centre. The green slopes are marked by white scars of limestone rock forming dramatic outcrops, and the remains of a lead mining industry can be traced on the hillsides around the village.

**Withernsea East Yorkshire**  
 This traditional resort has a delightful seafront with a sandy beach, backed by granite rocks, a wide promenade, ornamental gardens and an open-air stage. The Pier Towers on the promenade are the last surviving parts of the 19th century pier, destroyed during a storm in 1893. Now restored, the towers contain several exhibitions, the Coastal Change Observatory, and art and craft stalls. Unusually, the lighthouse was built inland and stands in the town centre, towering 38m over the rooftops.

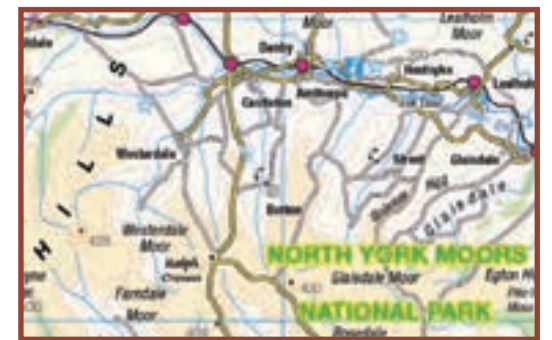

**Westerdale North York Moors**  
 Remote and beautiful elevated moorland, covered in vibrant purple heather in late summer, surrounds this green dale where land has been farmed for thousands of years. On the south-west of the moor a prehistoric standing stone is one of several stone alignments, part of the Flat Howe tumulus, an ancient burial site. A series of small streams, the Esklets, rising high on the North York Moors, merge to form the River Esk, which flows through Westerdale, the most westerly dale in the Esk Valley.

**City Hall, Bradford West Yorkshire**  
 Once the wool capital of the world, Bradford expanded from the mid-19th century on the wool processing trade. Seen illuminated and reflected in the Mirror Pool in the City Park, Bradford City Hall was built in 1873 in Venetian gothic style, inspired by the Palazzo Vecchio, Florence. 35 statues of past British monarchs grace the façade and a 60m belfry with 13 chiming bells rises above the building. The internal rooms and ceremonial staircase epitomise beautifully preserved Victorian splendour.

**Levisham North York Moors**  
 This beautiful, isolated moorland village, with a watermill on Levisham Beck, overlooks Newton Dale. Levisham station is one of the stops on the North Yorkshire Moors Steam Railway, winding through spectacular woods and moors between Grosmont and Pickering. The moors are rich in flora and fauna, and archaeological remains of Bronze and Iron Age settlements. It is close to the Hole of Horcum, a stunning natural amphitheatre created over millennia by a series of landslides caused by water pressure.

**Near Hawes, Wensleydale Yorkshire Dales**  
 Hawes is Yorkshire's highest market town, set in beautiful Upper Wensleydale, with a livestock market and a history of sheep farming and rope making. At the Wensleydale Creamery, visitors can watch the famous cheese being produced. The largest of the Yorkshire Dales, Wensleydale is a long broad valley, a mosaic of fells, moors, pastures, dry-stone walls, farms and barns, and stone villages. Unlike the other Yorkshire Dales, it is not named after the river flowing through it, which is the Ure.

**Calder Valley West Yorkshire**  
 The rugged and steep-sided Upper Calder Valley, seen here in winter, is part of the beautiful South Pennines area of river valleys, moorland and hill country. The fast-flowing streams descending from deep valley into the River Calder were used for early water power in the industrial development of the area. The 37m-high Stoodley Pike Monument is a landmark is on the skyline above the market town of Todmorden, visible for miles around. It was built in 1856 and is sited near the Pennine Way.
